With the approval of the Graduate School Committee, departments can provide open lectures for those wishing to gain knowledge and techniques necessary for general education and academic research.

- Research Assistant

(1) Research Assistants are divided into General Research Assistants and Post-Course Research Assistants.

(i) General RA: General Research Assistantships are provided to those eligible for admission to graduate school who want to take certain courses or studies at the Graduate School after approval by the President, as long as this does not disturb the regular course progression through graduate school.

(ii) Post-Course RA: Post-Course Research Assistantships are provided to those who have completed courses in accordance with Article 22 and who are undertaking research for degrees.

(2) To be a General RA, a student should have the recommendation of an advisor and should pass the examination conducted by the graduate school.

(3) General RAs with excellent research records can be issued a Certificate of Research Outcome in accordance with separate stipulations made by the President.
